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Present Status (starting 2013): Prof. Dr. Inge Seiffge-Krenke has been head of the Department of Developmental Psychology at the Johannes Gutenberg-University in Mainz, Germany until 2013. Today she is teaching at different universities including Psychologische Hochschule and International Psychoanalytic University, both in Berlin. Also schooling at Universidad Catholica, Lima, Peru. She is currently involved in longitudinal studies on close relations, including parent-adolescent relations, friendships and romantic relationships. In addition, she is leading an international project investigating stress and coping with samples based on data collected from 15.000 adolescents coming from 21 different countries. Additionally, Prof. Dr. Inge Seiffge-Krenke runs a project exploring the association between identity, family relations and psychopathology on adolescents and emerging adults in seven countries. The project is ongoing since 2013 and in 2018 the Society for Study of Emerging Adulthood (SSEA) honored her work by giving her the "Best International Research Award". Having finished a complete psychoanalytic training, Prof. Dr. Inge Seiffge-Krenke now supervises and carries out postgraduate psychotherapy education. Furthermore, she is member of the OPD-CA for 30 years now and worked with colleagues on the development of new diagnostic tools. Also, she is involved in the European Association for Research in Adolescence (EARA) since 1999, see below for specific activities.
